Long Mynd

The county of Shropshire has it all. From the picturesque Long Mynd and Stretton Hills to the market towns of Shrewsbury, Ludlow, Bridgnorth and Ironbridge, the birth place of industry., all overflowing with Castles, Abbeys and ancient buildings.

If history is your thing then a must see is the Blists Hill Victorian Town at Madeley and if you like to be scared, Blist Hill put on a spectacular night around Halloween or you can follow the ghost trail around Shrewsbury.
