# Lazy Times Christmas Cake



## Ingredients:

1 cup of water  
1 tsp baking soda  
1 cup of sugar  
1 tsp salt  
1 cup of brown sugar  
lemon juice  
4 large eggs  
lots of nuts  
1 bottle Vodka  
2 cups of dried fruit

Sample the vodka to check quality. Take a large bowl, check the vodka again. To be sure it is the highest quality, pour one level cup and drink.

Repeat.

Turn on the electric mixer. Beat one cup of butter in a large fluffy bowl.

Add one teaspoon of sugar. Beat again. At this point it's best to make sure the vodka is still OK.

Try another cup .... just in case. Turn off the mixer.

Break 2 eggs and add to the bowl and chuck in the cup of dried fruit.

Pick fruit off floor.

Mix on the turner.

If the dried fruit gets stuck in the beaters pry it loose with a screwdriver.
